1. Objectives of the organization reform:

In order to establish an organization which is able to conduct JANSI activities more efficiently, more effectively and systematically.


2. Points of the organization reform

- (1) Introduction of headquarter system
 - Organization with a President & CEO and an Executive Vice President will be incorporated and the following three headquarters will be created with the aim of perspective overviews of JANSI as a whole to enhance governance, etc.
 - "Planning and Administration Headquarter" will be created In order to strengthen business strategic functions.
 - In order to summarize the two major pillars of JANSI activities, "Safety Improvement Measures" and "Evaluations of Nuclear Plant Facilities (Peer Reviews) and assistance for them, "Safety System Headquarter" and "Evaluation & Assistance Headquarter" will be established.

(2) Readjustment of compositions of departments

In order to consolidate peer review activities which have been deconcentrated to multiple groups and enforce JANSI's readiness for peer reviews, existing departments will be restructured with group rearrangements according to appropriate review areas.
