Ruling by Osaka High Court to Cancel Provisional Disposition for Takahama Units 3 and 4

The Osaka High Court canceled on March 28, 2017 an provisional disposition order that has halted Takahama Nuclear Power Station Units 3 and 4.

## Outline of the ruling

- According to the explanation by the Kansai Electric Power Company, it is understood that the safety of Takahama units 3 and 4 meets the new regulatory requirements considering their safety improvement measures from the viewpoint of seismic safety and other aspects. Meanwhile, the other party is not able to fully explain the lack of safety of Takahama units 3 and 4. Accordingly, it has been concluded that the appeal for the provisional disposition order has no reasonable grounds.
- Therefore, the ruling made by the Ohtsu District Court should be canceled and the appeal for the order of the provisional disposition should be dismissed because the Osaka High Court finds the appeal for the provisional disposition is inappropriate.
