Planned shutdown of Onagawa Nuclear Power Station Unit 2

We stopped generating electricity at Onagawa Nuclear Power Station Unit 2 at 1:00 a.m. today, and systematically shut down the reactor at 8:09 a.m. *1.

This was a planned "intermediate shutdown*2" as part of the restart process, during which we will conduct safety checks of facilities and equipment.

We will continue to prioritize safety, stopping as necessary to conduct checks and thoroughly address each process.

*1 Reactor shutdown

All control rods will be inserted to their full insertion position, and the reactor mode switch will be turned from "start" to "refueling."

*2 Intermediate shutdown

As the reactor was started for the first time in 13 years, high-temperature, high-pressure steam was passed through the piping of various equipment in the reactor building and turbine building, and the reactor output reached the rated thermal output, the reactor will be temporarily shut down to conduct safety checks of facilities and equipment, and to inspect and clean the inside of the condenser.

The intermediate shutdown is scheduled to last for about 10 days from November 24.
