Start of Constant Rated Thermal Power Operation at Shimane Unit 2

We are pleased to announce that we have begun constant rated thermal power operation* at Shimane Nuclear Power Station Unit 2 (boiling water type, rated electrical output: 820,000 kW) at 4:00 today.

We will continue to prioritize safety and steadily confirm the soundness of the equipment in operation in order to resume commercial operations scheduled for January 10, 2025, and to continue stable operation thereafter.

* A method of operating the reactor power (amount of heat generated by the reactor) at a constant level near the maximum value (2,436 MW) approved by the government. Electrical output may fluctuate from 820,000 kW.
