

Planned Shutdown of Kashiwazaki-Kariwa Nuclear Power Station Unit 6  
(Disclosure Category I)

January 22, 2026

Kashiwazaki-Kariwa Nuclear Power Station Unit 6 withdrew control rods and started up the reactor at 7:02 p.m. on January 21. However, on January 22 at 12:28 a.m., during the control rod withdrawal operation, an alarm was triggered in the control rod operation monitoring system regarding one control rod, and the withdrawal operation was suspended.

We are currently continuing the investigation, but as the cause investigation is expected to take time, we have decided to temporarily shut down the plant in a planned manner today and inspect the relevant component.

We will provide an update on the investigation results as soon as they become available.

Going forward, if any issues arise, relevant personnel will gather to discuss and respond carefully to each matter with safety as the top priority.
